



NOTICE OF RACE

2019 Flights of Spring Regatta

April 20 & 21, 2019

1 RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*,
- 1.2** Sail Canada prescriptions will apply as well as the Equipment Rules of Sailing to the extent that they apply, the rules of the participating classes and this Notice of Race.
- 1.3** If there is a conflict between the official Notice of Race and any Preliminary Notice of Race, the official Notice of Race will take priority.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category "C".

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1** Skippers wishing to register boats in this event must be members of Good Standing of a recognized yacht/sailing club/association or National Authority.
- 3.2** Eligible classes are as follows: International Laser; International Laser Radial; International Laser 4.7; International Tasar; International F18 Class; International 29er; and X-Class.

4 FEES

- 4.1** The entry fee for the single-handed boats shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00).
The entry fee for the double-handed boats shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00).

- 4.2 Competitors may pay their entry fee at registration, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC. Credit card and debit payments can be paid in the Jericho office.
- 4.3 Cheques are to be made out to the “Jericho Sailing Centre Association”

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Racing for all classes will take place on Saturday, April 20, 2019 and on Sunday, April 21, 2019.
- 5.2 Registration will take place on Saturday, April 20, 2010 between 10:00 hrs and 12:00 hrs. at the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC
- 5.3 The scheduled time for the warning signal of the first start of the first race on Saturday, April 20 is 13:00 hrs. The scheduled time for the warning signal of the first start of the race on Sunday, April 21 is 12:30 hrs.
- 5.4 A competitors' meeting will be held at 12:00 hrs on Saturday April 20 at the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on April 20, 2019.

7 ACCOMMODATION

- 7.3 There will be some private accommodation available.

8 VENUE

The venue for this event will be the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC. The sailing will take place on English Bay.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty for the 29ers and F18 classes.
- 9.2 RRS 44.2 is in effect for all classes.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The Low Point scoring system in Appendix A4.2 will apply.
- 10.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 10.3** (a) When 4 races or less have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores.
 (b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 (c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

11 THE COURSES

11.1 The course to be sailed shall be displayed on the starting line boat no later than the preparatory signal for each class.

11.2 The courses to be sailed are as follows: all marks to be left to port.

11.3 A course diagram will be included with the sailing instructions.

FLAG	COURSE	MARKS
1	Standard Triangle	Start – 1 (1A) – 2 – 3 – Finish
2	Windward – Leeward	Start – 1 (1A) – 3 – Finish
3	Bermudan Triangle	Start – 1 (1A) – 2 – 3 – 1 (1A) – 3 – Finish
4	2 X Windward – Leeward	Start – 1 (1A) – 3 – 1 (1A) – 3 – Finish

11.4 Courses may be shortened or abandoned according to RRS 32.

11.5 Mark 1A will be a contrasting colour from Marks 1, 2 & 3

12 PRIZES

There will be prizes for the top three sailors in each class.

13 SOCIAL

There will be no food included in the entry fee. Alcohol may be purchased at the bar but must be consumed in the designated areas.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 Decision to Race. The organizing authorities, the Jericho Laser Fleet and the Jericho Centre Association will not accept any liability for material or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
