



NOTICE OF RACE

Andy Hunt Celebrational Regatta May 18-19, 2019 Jericho Sailing Centre Association

1. Host Club

The Jericho Sailing Centre Association will be both the host club and the organizing authority.

2. Rules

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*,

2.2 Sail Canada prescriptions will apply as well as the Equipment Rules of Sailing to the extent that they apply, the rules of the participating classes and this Notice of Race.

2.3 If there is a conflict between the official Notice of Race and any Preliminary Notice of Race, the official Notice of Race will take priority.

3. Advertising

Advertising will be restricted to Category "C".

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Tasar, F18, 505, Lightning and 29er classes.

3.2 Additionally and as an incentive for others to participate in sailboat racing in a less intimidating setting a Fun Class will accept all forms of sailing dinghies and windsurfers under 21 feet in length.

3.3 All sailors must sign the registration form (including the waiver). Parents and / or Legal Guardians must sign for under-age sailors.

3.4 Membership in BC Sailing / Sail Canada or a similar national authority is strongly advised.

4. Fees

4.1 The cost for the regatta is \$15 for single handed boats and \$30 for double handed boats.

4.2 Dinner is included for regatta registrants. Extra dinner tickets can be purchased for \$15.

4.3 Participation in the Saturday evening celebration of Andy Hunt's life is free.

6. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. ACCOMMODATION

7.3 Limited camping in enclosed campers in the parking lot and tents in the compound available.

7.4 There will be some private accommodation available.

8. VENUE

The venue for this event will be the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC. The sailing will take place on English Bay.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

9.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty for the 29ers and F18 classes.

9.2 RRS 44.2 is in effect for all classes.

10. SCORING

10.1 The Low Point scoring system in Appendix A4.2 will apply.

10.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.3 (a) When 4 races or less have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

11. THE COURSES

11.1 The course to be sailed shall be displayed on the starting line boat no later than the preparatory signal for each class.

11.2 The courses to be sailed are as follows: all marks to be left to port.

11.3 A course diagram will be included with the sailing instructions.

Flag 1 Course: Standard Triangle
Marks: Start – 1 (1A) – 2 – 3 – Finish

Flag 2 Course: Windward – Leeward
Marks: Start – 1 (1A) – 3 – Finish

Flag 3 Course: Bermudan Triangle Marks:
Start – 1 (1A) – 2 – 3 – 1 (1A) – 3 – Finish

Flag 4 Course: 2 X Windward – Leeward
marks: Start – 1 (1A) – 3 – 1 (1A) – 3 – Finish

11.4 Courses may be shortened or abandoned according to RRS 32.

11.5 Mark 1A will be a contrasting colour from Marks 1, 2 & 3

11.6 The race committee may add a beach start to the first race of the day. Skippers will start from a line on the beach, run down to their craft (which may be held in the water by a crew member or a third party) and then reach to the start line and continue up the course.

12. Prizes

Draw prizes will be awarded by a randomized process. All registered competitors will be eligible for draw prizes. Other prizes based on placing may also be awarded.

13. Social

A dinner and celebration of Andy Hunt's life will take place on Saturday May 18th at 1730H. Alcohol may be purchased at the bar but must be consumed in the designated areas. Additional dinner tickets for non-competitors may be purchased ahead of time.

14. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 Decision to Race. The organizing authority, the Jericho Sailing Centre Association, its staff and volunteers and sponsors will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior, to, during or after the regatta.
