### **Jericho Rescue :**

- all work in hand
- concern re electrolysis on motor being investigated

### **Jericho Marks:**

- survey to be done in April to determine seaworthiness of the boat. This will determine remaining life, and allow better planning of a replacement boat. When replacement is required, suggestion was to look at Lifetimer as it would be of suitable construction specification.
- Motor will not be replaced this year, unless we have serious issues with it.

### **Albatross:**

- deficiency list indicates minimal work required
- Ray to organize work parties in near future
- Decision made not to replace fixed radio ( due to theft risk), but will replace with handheld

### **Zodiac :**

- requires engine service
- should start planning replacement/ refurbishing. Suggestion to install orange tubes at that time. This allows differentiation from all other small inflatables at JSCA

### **Jericho Rescue Training :**

- will be held on April 26 & 27.
