4. PRESIDENT'S REPORT – Chris Stairs

Chris led a discussion of several items including: activity levels at Jericho since the board's December meeting; King Tides, compound flooding, rising sea levels and future flood modeling; Jericho Pier repair and replacement planning; continuing successful efforts to minimize the spread of Covid-19 through 2021; monitoring public health guidelines in advance of our busy season, still a few months away; Covid-19 Emergency Wage Subsidy and new federal student grant program.

6. TREASURER'S REPORT – Mike Stonefield

Mike presented the December budget report which completes our first fiscal quarter. CEWS contributions put us ahead of schedule in our slowest annual revenue period.

Benoit reported on a structural wood rot problem discovered during the Albatross annual refit. The problem must be addressed this year and will require additional funding to that anticipated in the current budget. Competing professional estimates have been acquired. The increased budget request includes a contingency.

9. GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT - Mike Cotter

Jericho Sailing Centre Covid-19 Safety Protocols are still in full effect as the pandemic situation is worse now than ever. Some members have been letting their guard down and Mike is asking directors who are winter users to help staff remind them to remain diligent. We are seeing Covid outbreaks in other recreational facilities (ski hills, etc.) and we must not contribute to the spread of the virus.

Jericho Lands
