## NOTICE OF RACE (NoR)

### 1 Rules

The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### 2 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available before July 17 on the event page at [jsca.bc.ca/events](http://jsca.bc.ca/events).

### 3 Communication

**3.1** The official notice board is located in the foyer of the Jericho Sailing Centre. Results will also be posted on [jracing.org](http://jracing.org).

**3.2 [DP]** While racing from the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

### 4 Eligibility and Entry

**4.1** The event is open to all boats of the F18, Hobie 18, Hobie 17, and Hobie 16 classes. Other catamaran classes may petition the organizing authority for inclusion.

**4.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing registration at [jracing.org](http://jracing.org), together with submitting the required fees, to the JSCA office by 1130 hrs July 17, 2021. Non JSCA members need to fill out the liability waiver at [jsca.bc.ca/waiver](http://jsca.bc.ca/waiver).

**4.3** Membership in BC Sailing or another provincial or national sailing association is recommended.

### 5 Fees

Entry fees are \$15 per person.

### 6 Schedule

**6.1** The scheduled time of the first warning signal on July 17 and 18 is 1230 hrs.

**6.2** Included in the cost of registration is a BBQ for participants and volunteers after racing on Saturday July 17.

**6.3** On July 18, 2021 no warning signal will be made after 1600 hrs.

### 7 Courses

The course will be in the area of English Bay North of the Jericho Sailing Centre.

### 8 Penalty System

For all catamaran classes RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

### 9 Scoring

**9.1** One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

**9.2** A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

**9.3 (a)** When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

**9.3 (b)** When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

**9.3 (c)** When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

### **10 Rights to Use Name and Likeness**

By participating in the Jericho Cat Classic, competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

### **11 Risk Statement and Liability**

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's

decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. *Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.* The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after Jericho Cat Classic event.
