## Notice of Race (NoR) Amendment 2

**Item 2.1 of the NoR is amended to read:**

- 2.1** The sailing instructions will be available on or before 1200hrs on June 22, 2022 at <https://jsca.bc.ca/event/2022-ilca-canadian-masters-championships/> and on the notice board in the foyer of the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery St, Vancouver BC.

**Item 4.2 of the NoR is amended to read:**

**4.2 Rig-Swapping Rule**

Unless a minimum of 12 ILCA-7 and 12 ILCA-6 entries have been received by June 19 2022, all entrants shall start and finish together and be scored as a single fleet. Competitors may choose ILCA-7, ILCA-6 or ILCA-4 rigs at their discretion, and change rigs throughout the regatta, provided that all rig changes are made on shore and all sails have the same number (Rig-Swapping Rule turned on).

Providing that a minimum of 12 ILCA-7 and 12 ILCA-6 entries have been received by by June 19 2022, both fleets shall be given separate starts (Rig-Swapping Rule turned off). Rig-Swapping between ILCA-6 and ILCA-4s shall always be in effect.

This changes ILCA Class Rule 29(d) by permission of the International Laser Class Association of North America.

**Status:** Rig swapping rule turned off – ILCA 6 and 7 fleets shall be given separate starts.

Saturday June 25

Sunday June 26

1130 hrs: Warning signal for first of 3 scheduled races  
1500 hrs: No warning signal will be made after this time  
1700 hrs: Awards ceremony

**Item 9 of the NoR is amended to read:**

**9** Courses

**9.1** Courses will be windward-leeward, triangle or variations thereof. Course length will be adjusted to target a race time of 45-60 minutes. Courses will be specified in detail in the Supplemental Sailing Instructions.
