

NOTICE OF RACE

2022 Sunday Racing Series Jericho Sailing Centre Association

1 Rules

- 1.0 The series will be governed by the current edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of Sail Canada, the rules of the participating classes and this Notice of Race, except as amended by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.
- **1.1** RRS 40 and the preamble to Part IV are amended so that competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while on the water. Wet suits or dry suits do not qualify as personal flotation devices.
- **1.2** For multihull classes, RSS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- **1.3** Protocols related to COVID-19 may be published at any time, state when they will take effect, and will state if they have the status of a rule.

2 Eligibility and Entry

All naturally powered craft 21 feet and under may participate in the JSCA Sunday Racing Series. All Competitors must be JSCA members or registered guests and sign the JSCA membership waiver. Parents and / or Legal Guardians must sign for under-age sailors. Sailors should register at jracing.org before the start of the event but may register at any time afterwards until the last day of racing on the JSCA event calendar. Membership in BC Sailing / Sail Canada (\$22.00) is strongly advised.

3 Fees

There are no fees for participating in the Sunday Racing Series.

4 Schedule of Races

Every non-regatta Sunday between May 1 and September 4, 2022.

The scheduled time for the warning signal of the first start of the first race on each date is 1230 hrs.

5 Venue

The venue is the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery St. Vancouver BC. Races will be conducted in English Bay north of the Centre.

6 Sailing Instructions & Courses

The standard JSCA Sailing Instructions (available at: https://jsca.bc.ca/wp-content/uploads/2019/12/JSCA-SIs-with-courses-Jan-2020.pdf) will be used for the Tuesday Nite Series. The courses to be sailed are defined in the sailing instructions.
