Notice of Race (NoR)

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 Rules

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, the prescriptions of Sail Canada, the rules of the specific classes involved, except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race.
- 1.2 [DP] RRS 40 and the preamble to Part IV are amended so that competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while on the water except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits or dry suits do not qualify as personal flotation devices.
- 1.3 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty for the 29er and all multi-hull classes.
- 1.4 Protocols related to COVID-19 may be published at any time, state when they will take effect, and will state if they have the status of a rule.

2 Sailing Instructions

3 Communication

- 3.1 The official notice board is in the foyer of the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery St, Vancouver, BC.
- 3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the ILCA 7, ILCA 6, ILCA 4, Tasar, F18, Hobie 18, Martin 16, 505, Lightning and 29er classes. Other classes with adequate numbers may be added at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 4.2** Additionally and as an incentive for others to participate in sailboat racing in a less intimidating setting a Fun Class will accept all forms of sailing dinghies and windsurfers under 21 feet in length.
- 4.3** All sailors must sign the JSCA liability waiver (current JSCA members in good standing will have already signed this as a condition of membership). Parents and/or legal guardians must sign for under-age sailors. Participants can sign the waiver at: <https://www.waiver-file.com/b/jsca/Waiver.aspx>
- 4.4** Membership in BC Sailing/Sail Canada or a similar national authority is strongly advised.
- 4.5** [NP] Entrants who develop known symptoms of COVID-19 during the event must recuse themselves from competing and are not to show up at the venue. Entrants who knowingly compete while positive with COVID-19 will be disqualified (unless they can prove they have recovered from COVID-19 for more than 10 days).
- 4.6** [NP] Entrants must adhere to all posted Jericho Sailing Centre COVID-19 protocols while at the venue.

5 Fees

- 5.1** Fees for current JSCA members are \$0 and \$5/day for non-members.

6 Schedule

- 6.2** Saturday July 23
0930-1200 hrs: Fee payment and waiver signing for non-member participants
1200 hrs: Competitors meeting
1300 hrs: Warning signal for first race of the day
1630 hrs: Approximate end of racing for the day

Sunday July 24

- 1100 hrs: Warning signal for first race of the day
1500 hrs: No warning signal will be made after this time

7 Equipment Inspection

7.1 Boats may be inspected at any time.

8 Venue

8.1 The event venue is the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery St, Vancouver, BC.

8.2 The racing area is English Bay.

9 Courses

9.1 Courses will be windward-leeward, triangle or variations thereof. Course length will be adjusted to target a race time of 25-40 minutes. Courses will be specified in detail in the Sailing Instructions.

9.2 Marks will be inflatable tetrahedrons.

10 Scoring

10.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2 The low point system as described in RRS Appendix A, Section A4 in is effect.

10.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worst scores.

11 Risk Statement

11.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

11.2 The organizing authority, the Jericho Sailing Centre Association, its staff, volunteers and sponsors will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior, to, during or after the 2022 Andy Hunt Celebrational Regatta.

11.3 It is recommended that competitors carry adequate liability insurance.
