To bring forward ideas of how the JSCA might better meet our Mission Statement.

3. Member Ideas

- - Improve boat transport and storage in the compound for elderly and physically challenged people: rollers or hydraulic lift for higher rack spots.
- - Specialty dollies for kayaks, rowing shells, SUP, etc.
- - More “Public Welcome” signage to let people know we are a community centre by the sea
- - More way finding signage – better identification of school, restaurant and washroom locations.
- - LED entrance sign for facility and event messaging; recurring events on sign; weather info., etc.
- - Awnings to improve building aesthetics.
- - Improve service/main office/reception configuration – exterior service counter.
- - Focus on improving safety & seamanship education – SUP in particular
- - Host a “Seamanship Day” for members and the public.
- - Solve problem with unleashed dogs on the beach and in the compound.
- - More focus on environmentally friendly initiatives & energy sustainability – LED lighting.
- - Include energy sustainability in the long term Capital Plan.
- - Discussion of possible long term concepts, including: a DSA dock facility and 3rd floor development.
- - Concern that JSCA address challenges while continuing to meet it’s mandate for low cost, highly accessible recreational ocean access for small, naturally powered craft.
