

**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**2014 Jericho Classic Regatta**  
**2014 North American Tasar Championships**  
May 31<sup>st</sup> and June 1<sup>st</sup> 2014

**1 RULES**

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*,
- 1.2** CYA prescriptions will apply as well as the Equipment Rules of Sailing to the extent that they apply, the rules of the participating classes and this Notice of Race.
- 1.3** If there is a conflict between the official Notice of Race and any Preliminary Notice of Race, the official Notice of Race will take priority.

**2 ADVERTISING**

Advertising will be restricted to Category "C".

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1** Skippers wishing to register boats in this event must be members of Good Standing of a recognized yacht/sailing club/association or National Authority.
- 3.2** Eligible classes are the International Laser, the International Laser Radial, International 505, the International Tasar, the International Hoot, the International Martin 16 and X-Class.
- 3.3** Membership in the North American Tasar Association (NATA) is mandatory for those sailors who are participating in the 2014 Tasar North American Championships as per NATA class rules

**4 FEES**

- 4.1** The entry fee for the single-handed boats shall be \$30.00 CAN. The entry fee for the double-handed boats shall be \$50.00 CAN.
- 4.2** Competitors may pay their entry fee at registration, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC. Credit card payments can be paid in the Jericho office.
- 4.3** Competitors may make alternative arrangements for payment by contacting the JSCA Fleet Captain, Andy Hunt at: 604-733-9663 or athunt@vcn.bc.ca.

**5 SCHEDULE**

- 5.1** Racing for all classes will take place on Saturday, May 31 and Sunday June 1, 2014.
- 5.2** Registration will take place on Saturday, May 31<sup>st</sup> between 10:00 hrs and 12:00 hrs. at the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC
- 5.3** The scheduled time for the warning signal of the first start of the first race on May 31 is 1300 hrs. The scheduled time for the warning signal of the first start of the first race on June 1 is 1200 hrs.
- 5.4** The competitors' meeting will be at 1200 hrs. on May 31 2014 at the Jericho Sailing Centre.

**6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on May 31, 2014.

**7.3** There will be some private accommodation available.

**7.4** There will be a limited number of tents allowed in the Jericho compound.

## **8 VENUE**

The venue for this event will be the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC. The sailing will take place on English Bay.

## **9 PENALTY SYSTEM**

**9.1** RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be in effect for all classes except skiffs and the Martin 16.

**9.2** Skiffs and the Martin 16's are required to do one penalty turn including one tack and one gybe.

## **10 SCORING**

**10.1** The Low Point scoring system in Appendix A4.2 will apply.

**10.2** One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

**10.3** (a) When 4 races or less have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

## **11 THE COURSES**

**11.1** The course to be sailed shall be displayed on the starting line boat no later than the preparatory signal for each class.

**11.2** The courses to be sailed are as follows: all marks to be left to port.

**11.3** A course diagram will be included with the sailing instructions.

FLAG	COURSE	MARKS
1	Standard Triangle	Start – 1 (1A) – 2 – 3 – Finish
2	Windward – Leeward	Start – 1 (1A) – 3 – Finish
3	Bermudan Triangle	Start – 1 (1A) – 2 – 3 – 1 (1A) – 3 – Finish
4	2 X Windward – Leeward	Start – 1 (1A) – 3 – 1 (1A) – 3 – Finish

**11.4** Courses may be shortened or abandoned according to RRS 32.

**11.5** Mark 1(A) will be a contrasting color from Mark 1.

## **12 PRIZES**

There will be prizes for the top three sailors in each class. In addition, there will be some draw prizes. There also might be some additional prizes.

## **13 SOCIAL**

There will be food included in the entry fee. Alcohol may be purchased at the bar but must be consumed in the designated areas.

## **14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 Decision to Race. The organizing authorities, the Jericho Laser Fleet and the Jericho Centre Association will not accept any liability for material or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
