NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

1.2 Sail Canada prescriptions will apply as well as the Equipment Rules of Sailing to the extent that they apply, the rules of the participating classes and this Notice of Race.

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising is restricted to Category "C"

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Regatta is open to all boats of the International Tasar Class.

3.2 Skippers wishing to register boats in this event must be members of Good Standing of a recognized yacht/sailing club/association or National Authority.

3.3 Youth sailors must have a parent or legal guardian sign the waiver/liability form in order for them to be considered for entry into the regatta

4. FEES

4.1 There will be no entry fee for the event

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on 7th September

6 VENUE

The venue for this event will be the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery, Vancouver, BC. The sailing will take place on English Bay.

7 ACCOMMODATION

7.3 There may be some private accommodation available.

7.4 There will be a limited number of tents allowed in the Jericho compound.

7.5 RV parking is permitted in the parking lot adjacent to the Jericho compound.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be in effect.

9 SCORING

9.1 The Low Point scoring system in Appendix A4.2 will apply.

9.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

10 THE COURSES

10.1 Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

10.2 The course number to be sailed shall be displayed on the starting line boat no later than the preparatory signal.

10.3 Courses may be shortened or abandoned according to RRS 32.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4

11.2 Decision to Race. The organizing authorities and the Jericho Sailing Centre Association will not accept any liability for material or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
